**MUCH ACTIVITY IS NOTICEABLE AT FREIBURG**  
 Olympia Mining Co. Carries Forward Development With Splendid Results  
 The old camp of Freiburg, 116 miles east of Tonopah, is showing a great deal of activity these days and by early spring it is anticipated that the district will be in a high state of productivity from a mineral standpoint. The Olympia Mining company,

composed largely of Salt Lake interests, and headed by Congressman Leuegood of Utah, is employing a force of 12 men in development and highly gratifying results have been forthcoming. The crosscut tunnel has been driven for 800 feet, where a vein was intersected having a width of four feet—all ore—since which time drifting has progressed for 100 feet to the southeast, with pay mineral being exposed the entire distance. The ore is a silver-lead and of a commercial grade, but in order to secure the best results it has been decided that a modern concentrating plant should be erected, and to that end the interested parties are making plans accordingly.  
 The holdings of the Combination Divide Mining company adjoin the Olympia on the southwest and plans are now formulating whereby an extensive campaign of development will
