SHERIFF'S SALE.

BY VIRTUE OF A DECREE AND Order of Sale issued out of and under the seal of the Honorable Second Judicial District Court, in and for the county of Ormsby, State of Nevada, on a judgment obtained therein on the 10th day of November, A. D. 1876, and attested on the 21st day of November, A. D. 1876, in favor of Wells, Fargo & Company, and against A. B. Trisbach, Tremor, Coffin and J. W.
