This applies not only to wagon and stage lines, wood trails and mining roads, but railroads as well. Every camp south, now reached by railroad, can be reached easily from this city.

Freight rates and passenger fares are as cheap to and from here as in any part of the state. The service is better than on any other railroads or stage routes in the state.

The merchants of this city carry large stocks and make close prices.
