One of the best machine shops in the country is in active operation here. The only adequate foundry in the state is here, ready for business, and it can cast light or heavy hardware, and machine parts with equal facility.

When it comes to general repairs on mining machinery and stamp mills, building or assembling of hoists and engines, this shop has few equals on the coast, and none in the state approach it for facilities and adequate tools.

From the heavier work to the lines known as "shell hardware" the merchants of the city can supply all wants. There are three or four wholesalers in Carson City that make a specialty of mining supplies both light and heavy, to say nothing of general camp goods for outfitting a new organization for campaign in the field.

Prospecting parties may be fitted out in Carson City with every thing needed for trips in the desert, and for work on a ledge when one is found.
