The republican press of the state is busily engaged in attempting to show how virtuous and high minded, how solicitous for the welfare of the working man and how honest the republican platform and republican candidates are.

Turning the statements seriatim, the virtue and high mindedness is a bit clouded by the evident desire to continue in the good graces of the insurance and other trusts, to the end that the sack may be opened and a bunch of money turned loose for use of the faithful, in this campaign.

As to the working men, the friendliness of a republican administration for that class is like the friendliness of a wolf in sheep's clothing, all smiles and promises now; but let the employees liability law be talked about and then where are they? Like Mitchell, Smith and Dodge who are accused, and have not denied the accusation, of writing, with others, to Senator Nixon, to vote AGAINST that measure when it came up in the U. S. Senate.

Compare that action with the passage and enforcement of the eight hour law by the democratic administration of this state and the democratic governor of this state, who said in Reno less than ten days ago, "Law and order must prevail," thus giving notice that the eight hour law must be observed.
