OBLIVION FOR TRUSTS' CANDIDATES

ALL of the Trusts' candidates in the House are in imminent danger of political oblivion. They are openly opposed to the re-establishment of a direct vote in the people and must take the consequences. Ex-chairman Babcock in Wisconsin is opposed by a majority rule democrat; as also is speaker Cannon, Mr. Hepburn, Mr. Jenkins, Mr. Wadsworth, and nearly every one of the Republican chairmen of the Congressional Committees. There are some notable exceptions, among them being Mr. Moon of Philadelphia, chairman of the committee on revision of laws, who says:

"The general principle of the Advisory Initiative and the Referendum are certainly steps in the right direction toward giving the people a more direct controlling voice in national legislation. This principle I would advocate and would lend my influence and my vote to re-establish."

"Whenever the will of my constituents is made known to me through any other recognized medium of registering their will respecting national legislation, I will cheerfully obey their instructions."

What answer to this can be offered by the Nevada Republican nominee for Congress? Yet he is opposing it and the democrat is championing it. This is the case in 174 districts throughout the country. Aristocracy is openly pitted against majority rule—the people's rule.
