REPUBLICAN STATE CONVENTION

AT A MEETING OF THE Republican State Central Committee of Nevada, held at Virginia City, March 2, 1884, the following resolutions were adopted:

Resolved, That it is hereby ordered that a State Convention BE HELD AT CARSON CITY, ORMSBY CO., IN THIS STATE, ON Thursday, September 4, 1884

At the hour of 1 o'clock p. m. of said day, for the purpose of nominating 3 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS, 1 MEMBER OF CONGRESS and 1 JUDGE OF SUPREME COURT.

Resolved, That the basis of representation in said Conventions of April 9 and September 4 shall be one vote for each and every 100 votes, or fraction of 50 or over 50, cast at the last State election for the Republican candidate for Judge of the Supreme Court, to-wit:

Table listing counties and their number of votes: Churchill county (1), Douglas county (2), Elko county (7), Esmeralda county (7), Eureka county (9), Humboldt county (4), Lander county (5), Lincoln county (3), Lyon county (3), Ormsby county (6), Storey county (16), Washoe county (16), White Pine county (8), Total (77).

Resolved, That the several Republican County Committees of the State are hereby instructed to call a Primary Election of the people of their respective counties on Saturday, April 12, 1884, for the purpose of electing Delegates to the State Convention to be held at Carson City, September 4, 1884...

Resolved, That if a vacancy should occur in any delegation to the Primary Election, and such vacancy shall be filled by the remaining Delegates.

Resolved, That the following test be required of each and every voter at the said Primary Election: "Are you a Republican? And will you support the nominees of the Republican National Convention and of the Republican State Convention?"
