

The issue of the Morrison resolution to dispose of the surplus in the Treasury in redeeming the obligations of the Government is awaited in London with keen interest, as it concerns the standing and functions of silver. The Governor of the Bank of England denounces the absurd comments of certain English and American newspapers upon the American silver movement as in some way threatening repudiation, and frankly declares his belief that the United States Government has the absolute right to pay its debt in silver, as has India, and that is what India is doing.

This rebuke from the head of the largest banking institution in the world, and in a country too, where silver is demonetized, and where large amounts of United States bonds are held, ought to silence the gold bugs and their organs, but it does not have that effect. The New York Tribune, the leading Republican journal of the United States, is not abashed by the merited rebuke, but declares that it is time to stop trying by legislation to force silver upon a people who have no need of it. The Tribune does not stop to consider that the United States, with a debt of \$1,339,136,383, for which silver is a legal tender, cannot have too much of that coin. The trouble is, however, that the financial affairs of the Government are being conducted as they have been for years, and instead of relieving the Treasury vaults by using standard dollars to redeem the debt for which they are a legal tender, and save the payment of interest, silver coin is hoarded against the protest of the people of the west and south, as expressed by their Representatives in Congress.—Silver State.

HEARST OUTGENERATED

An account was given some time ago of how Senator Hearst had stricken out of the River and Harbor bill the clause instructing the Secretary of War to bring suit against hydraulic miners in California who are filling up the navigable rivers with debris, as it was stated that the Secretary of War would not use any portion for the improvement of the Sacramento or San Joaquin rivers until he was satisfied that hydraulic mining had closed. When Hearst had succeeded in eliminating from the River and Harbor bill the clause against hydraulic mining, McKenna went quietly to work to have it restored through Markham, who is on the committee and was one of the conferees. McKenna had the clause restored in conference, and yesterday it passed both houses. Senator Hearst not knowing anything about it. The River and Harbor bill now directs the Secretary of War to bring suit against hydraulic miners and compel them to cease depositing mining debris in navigable streams.

Artesian wells have been sunk in several places at and near Battle Mountain and flowing water found at a depth of less than 200 feet in every case. The Nevada Central Railway Company, stimulated by the success of these wells, has commenced sinking an artesian well at Clifton, near Austin. If a good flow of water is struck numerous wells will be bored in Reese River and Smoky valleys for irrigating purposes.
