**THE "APPEAL" BOYCOTTED.**

The proprietor of the APPEAL a little over a week ago, visited San Francisco to pay his respects to the National Encampment of the Grand Army of the Republic. On his return he finds that his paper has been placed under boycott, by a secret committee of individuals who have arrogated to themselves, in this city, the right to manage the business affairs of other people.

One firm stated that it did not wish to discontinue advertising but it had been "ordered" to do so and must obey. The committee were emissaries from the anti-Chinese League.

This boycott we look upon with the contempt which every honest American ought to have for it, and we spit upon the cowardice and malice which stalks behind it.

The proprietor of this paper gives constant employment to six people and occasional employment to three more. He employs no Chinese in the remotest way. It is clear then to the most thoughtless observer that the anti-Chinese League has not boycotted him because he is the friend of Mongolian labor.

There are two principal indictments however which lie against him

Ever since he has lived in Carson City he has striven to improve and develop the county and has fought in the interest of the Republican party. He has made grass, trees and live stock grow where they did not grow before; he has sunk artesian wells to practically demonstrate his faith in the water belt which underlies the country, to assist those who have an interest in the prosperity of Ormsby county and induce others to make fresh efforts in behalf of its prosperity. He has increased the value of taxable property, paid his debts and every dollar earned by the APPEAL has been spent in the city.

These facts constitute a portion of the indictments against the proprietor of this journal.

Another serious charge against the APPEAL is, that for fifteen years it has stood up and waged battle for the Republican party. To both these charges the accused parties plead guilty, and is now ordered to appear at the bar of the Garrard League and receive the sentence of Boycott.

We do not know who this secret committee is who take advantage of a man's absence from the State to stab his business, nor do we care to acquaint ourselves with men who can enjoy the exercise of such sneaking cowardice.

But we are used to such methods of warfare, and have been subjected to it for six years. If these men will crawl out from behind their ambush we will meet them in the open field, man to man. There is no honorable method of warfare through which we will not meet these men.

We would like to meet them at the Carson Opera House and debate the issue upon which they establish a boycott. We will discuss this issue with them; not before a crowd of loafers, idlers, tramps, non-producers and failures in politics and business, but before the intelligent, taxpaying, lawabiding and producing element of this community.

We would like to see a mass meeting of citizens gathered in this city to intelligently discuss the troubles now disturbing this community and ascertain who are the parties responsible for a persistent assault upon enterprise in Carson, and the disgraceful, inhuman and cowardly bounding of respectable young ladies in this community, who are making their living here in the honorable pursuit of teaching school.

The city owes it to itself to purge itself of the contempt with which it will be held by other localities if it fails to show the manhood necessary to defend its reputation from slander, its business interest from the interference of tramps and paupers, and its women from the indecent assaults of persons masquerading in the attire of men and trying to palm themselves off as gentlemen.

The Belfast rioters have been quieted.
