**CONTRASTED CANDIDATES.**

Never, in the history of Nevada politics, were two gubernatorial nominations made in which the principles presented such a wide contrast to the intelligent voter. Were C. C. Stevenson and Jewett Adams to travel in each other's company in a strange country the latter would probably be regarded as the body servant of the other. But it is idle here to contrast personal appearances between two persons known to almost every voter in the State. It is impossible to place C. C. Stevenson anywhere that his commanding and dignified presence will not proclaim him, and it is equally an impossibility to place Adams in a place where he will be anything more than a man to be laughed and sneered at.

Were Adams to remain in private life and keep his place no one would laugh or sneer at him; he is simply regarded as ridiculous from the fact he has attempted to fill a station in life for which he is in no way fitted, just as ignorant and badly bred women are made the subjects of ridicule by simply over-dressing and being loud and vulgar, imagining they are apeing the more gently bred.

Stevenson represents the style of men who are today and have been for years developing Nevada. He came to this State a poor man, and for a quarter of a century has fought, and successfully too, the hard battle for life that one must fight in Nevada. During this time he has never swerved from the clean path of honesty, and his dealings with his neighbor have been always based upon the equarest business principles.

During this quarter of a century now passing away, C. C. Stevenson has invested, speculated, developed the country and improved its condition. He has kept large amounts of money in circulation and paid out to wage workers \$3,000,000. His ambition has not been a political one; he has aimed to make this State better for man to live in. He has delved in the bowels of the earth, he has built flames, tilled land, made grass and trees grow where none grew before, and made the face of nature more pleasant to look at wherever his busy foot has trod.

Under his wand of enterprise, houses have sprung from the ground, hearthstones have blazed with light, the family pot kept boiling and the wolf of want kept from the door of thousands.

A man like C. C. Stevenson is the living emblem of State pride and State progress. He belongs to the intelligent pioneers of the sagebrush who have made the desert blossom and filled the air with the live hum of industry. It is not necessary for all to know C. C. Stevenson; His works proclaim him on every side. The clamor of the stamp mill, the dash of the water wheel, the clatter of the reaper and the light laughter of the employed, all tell of C. C. Stevenson's presence in this State. When any great enterprise is to be managed there is a general call for C. C. Stevenson to take the helm. He has managed great enterprises for years and headed public movement for the State's good.

Therefore it is not to be wondered at that he should be called upon to take command of the ship of State.

Can the organs of Governor Adams make any recitals of his works in this State? Where Stevenson has helped the common wealth, Adams has fattened off it. One the winged angel of progress, the other the insatiable vampire of rapacity and greed. The one representing the dignity and pride of Nevada, the other, the political treachery and chicanery, which has made Nevada a laughing stock and byword all over the West.

Circumstances have ordained the year of our Lord 1886, in which a disgusted people are to be delivered from any further participation in a State disgrace.


