CAN POWING DELIVER THE GOODS?

After having been defeated in the Republican party it is a well known fact that Powing entered into a conspiracy with the Democrats. They submitted to him their proposed nominees for the Legislature. He selected such as pleased him and rejected such as did not, and substituted therefor others who would do his bidding. He has now the patronage both as to appointments and trade of the State Prison, the Insane Asylum, the University, and the office of United States Surveyor General, which he holds under a Democratic Administration. With this patronage he has been able to influence nearly every person to whom he has given trade or whom he has appointed to place in these various institutions which he controls. On investigation it is ascertained that no person is now following him in his bait except those that are receiving favors from him as above stated. It was a mystery to the Republicans for some time as to how he was able to hold these particular individuals, but the explanation has come at last. He has told them that with a legislative delegation of his own from Washoe—whether Democratic or Republican—he can make sufficient trades in the Legislature to continue his followers in their enjoyment of the spoils. He is opposing the Republican Legislative nominees because he cannot use them for his political and financial purposes, and is therefore favoring the Democratic nominees because they are his stock in trade, by means of which he expects to continue as heretofore to control the entire patronage of the State.

There are persons, both Democratic and Republican, that doubt the capacity of Mr. Powing if he could get a full Democratic delegation from Washoe to continue to monopolize almost the entire patronage of the State and distribute it among his followers. It appears however, that many, if not all, of the present recipients of the State's bounty (dealt out to them by Mr. Powing), believe that he has the capacity to get the entire patronage for them if he could have the use of a Washoe delegation, and are working to that end. It seems hardly possible that persons who have good Republican records and have been regarded as honorable citizens, heretofore, should sell their principles and their honor on promises based upon such a flimsy showing and intrigue so disreputable and treacherous. It will not do for these men to come before a Republican Legislature and pretend they have voted the Republican ticket. No one will take their word for it unless they exhibit their tickets to some responsible person.

We advise all who are suspected of being implicated in this nefarious scheme to secure proof on the day of election that they voted the Republican ticket. The Republican party is in no humor to be betrayed first and then robbed of the patronage that belongs to honest Republicans who stood by their ticket.

The Gazette and the editor come in for their share of abuse because as a Republican paper it exposes the position of the enemies of the party. The Gazette has been more than fair with Mr. Powing. When he has been struggling for a nomination it has done nothing against him and when he got it the paper supported him, saying all the good things it could and none of the bad. When he did not get nominated and bolted it exposed him.

Will the citizens of Ormsby jeopardize the State Prison and the Orphans' Home by sending a delegation to the Legislature that will not be recognized?

After the Prison and the Home leave us, the Capitol goes next. The prosperity of Carson is of more moment than the success of the growlers.
