## REPUBLICAN PRIMARIES.

AT A MEETING OF THE  
Republican County Central Com-  
mittee, held at Carson City, April 23rd,  
1888, it was ordered that a primary election  
be held by the Republican party of  
Ormsby County, on

Saturday, April 28th, 1888.

For the purpose of electing eleven dele-  
gates to the state convention, to be held  
at Winnemucca, on the 5th day of  
May, 1888. Ordered that the delegates be  
appointed as follows:

The delegates receiving the highest  
number of votes cast throughout the  
county, subject to the apportionment

The polls are to be kept open at Car-  
son City from 9 A. M. until 6 P. M., and  
at Empire City from 11 A. M. until 6 P.  
M. Ordered that the following shall be  
Judges at the several places where pri-  
maries shall be held:

Carson, at the Curry Engine House, C. A.  
W. Threll, E. S. Daugherty, J. A.  
Kennedy.

Empire, at the old Postoffice (Walter-  
Building), James Hope, A. W. Morris,  
D. C. Blye.

Resolved that the following shall be  
the test for persons offering to vote at  
the primary election:

"I am a citizen of this State, and will  
support the nominees of the Republican  
party."

The attention of the Boards is respec-  
tfully called to the law governing pri-  
mary elections, Stats. 1881, pages 28  
and 29, inclusive; also Gen. Stat. of  
Nevada, sections 1021, to 1035
