THE FACTS IN THE CASE.

The Enterprize of yesterday morning publishes an editorial which may be something of a surprise to a good many people, but is by no means a surprise to the writer. It charges that the Louisiana Lottery sack is now in Nevada, straying by every means to defeat a proposition to establish a State Lottery. The editor of the APPEAL has known of the existence of this sack for two years and will, when the time comes, show to the public, just where the coin of the Louisiana Lottery Company has been advantageously placed. We have facts in our possession which show exactly how the coin of the Louisiana Lottery Company has been used to manufacture a wave of Pecksniffian morality intended to defeat the Lottery Bill. The APPEAL is an open and above board Lottery organ and has advocated in lottery in Nevada for the past seven years and we do not claim to be any more honest or moral than the balance of our neighbors. We will state, however, and can substantiate our statement, that on two occasions, an agent of the Louisiana Lottery Company called upon us from San Francisco, and proposed to pay the APPEAL, if it would fight the proposed lottery scheme. On the last interview we told the agent that we considered the establishment of a lottery matter of self protection to Nevada, and that no paper professing to fight for State interests could take such a course. By professing to favor his scheme, previously we obtained information from him, which if published, would make a number of high moral people in this State sick at the stomach and would also cause a number of people, (who are admiring the higher morality displayed by certain parties in the interests of "principle" so called) to also throw up their breakfast. We believe it is time to call a halt on this uprising of sham morality paid for by the Louisiana Lottery coin. Is any one foolish enough to imagine that the pamphlets and tickets that are being distributed and the agents at work through the State, howling against the Lottery, are doing it all at their own expense and because they fear that some awfully wicked thing is about to be perpetrated? Did any one ever see any of these people spending money to close up hogging faro games, or stud poker deal falls? The fact that the Louisiana company is exerting itself to prevent a Nevada Lottery is the most conclusive proof that they regard this State a rich plum in their business. The agent in his conversation with us said, "Nevada contributes more per capita to Louisiana than any State in the Union."

The passage of the Nevada Lottery Bill, means a large financial loss to the Louisiana company, a portion of the money which now goes to the Rebel Brigadiers will remain in Nevada and the people North of the Mason & Dixon line who patronize lotteries will send their money to the North instead of the South.

While the agent was discussing the proposition of fighting the State Lottery and laboring under the impression that the APPEAL would be a co-laborer on the harvest, we suggested that he secure an agent in the State Capitol building, he smiled and said, "That's all been attended to."

We do not wish to be understood here that every person opposing the Lottery scheme is not doing it from conscientious motives, but we knew positively that some of them would open their eyes, if they but knew that parties in whose high moral leads they are following, are making their crusade for coin and coin only.

We do not charge, nor do we wish it understood that all of the newspapers fighting the Nevada Lottery proposition are doing it for money, but we are cognizance of the fact that two newspapers we could name are fighting the proposition because they have been led to believe, by certain parties that it will be popular to do so on "high moral

grounds" of course. The joke of the business is that the parties who have "steered" the papers on to the New Orleans way of thinking are getting pay for the job and the duped editors are working for nothing.
