

WASHOE WINS.

Once more the APPEAL is called on to chronicle the fact that Washoe county has again been able to plant its knife in Ormsby. Washoe gives a majority of about 400 against the Lottery amendment, an amendment which, if carried, would have made Carson City the largest town in the State.

It seems almost incredible that any number of people in this city could have been found who would side with Washoe against the interests of their own county, but when ever Washoe wars on Ormsby it is always certain to find people in Carson who will aid and abet the fight.

They generally do it from a lack of forethought and from general ignorance of the situation, but the result is the same every time.

During the past ten years Ormsby has over and over again refused alliance with Storey's ten votes and coquetted with Washoe's three votes, and Washoe has invariably deceived, tricked and bulldozed us. This time she has again knifed us, and under the thin mask of an outraged "moral scruple," swept away the most magnificent chance Carson ever had of becoming a big town, and of course received the usual assistance she can always depend on among our own people.

Douglas county would also have been largely benefitted by Carson prosperity, for here is where she sells her produce.

With Douglas and Ormsby in line, solid for Amendment 22, the day would have been won without Washoe.

The people have been deceived by false guides, and Louisiana Lottery stock crawls up a notch or two in New Orleans, while the agents of the Company laugh in their sleeves to think how easily they duped the voters of Nevada.

In a few years the augmented State taxes, the lack of money to carry on irrigation projects and the reduced price of real estate will cause the very men who have opposed the lottery project to howl for the \$80,000 which will not be in the public treasury each session.

Licensing Gambling.

The following from the Sacramento Bee will be read with interest about this time:

We find the following little editorial paragraph in the Los Angeles Times:

Gambling goes on merrily and without molestation.

The same is true in Sacramento and other cities of the State—in fact in nearly all of them.

The idea that gambling can be stopped is theoretically an excellent one; practically, a failure. It has not been, and never will be stopped on earth. Such a reform is only possible in Heaven. And while we live on earth, we should endeavor to put up as best we may with the evils of earth.

That which we cannot stop should be regulated. And of such is the evil of gambling!

There can be no doubt that the licensing of gambling in Sacramento was the best thing that ever happened in this city. It was a blessing both to employer and employe, and it was so recognized by our most reputable citizens. The money that theretofore had been paid for the corruption of a police department was given in to the coffers of the city.

Gambling was not as rife as it had been. It was more decently conducted; and in every way, it was a most excellent thing. The gambler did not want it, however.

The ministers were opposed to it, because, they said it was licensing crime. A most peculiar combination went to work, and a bill was passed which made it a felony for any Board of Trustees to license the evil. That bill should be wiped off the Statute books in the interest of morality, and a license bill passed.

Gambling is an evil that will always exist. We cannot suppress it, therefore should we regulate it? It is much better to place it under

the control of the State than to have it go ahead wild and free, as it is going now. It is the height of folly to have eyes and not see; to be blind to an evil, rather than endeavor to keep it under control.
