GIBRALTAR will make the Season of 1889, at the Ranch, Carson City, Nev., commencing March 1st, and ending September 1st. Terms, \$40 the season with the privilege of return if the mare is not with foal, or \$30 to insure a foal.

### PEDIGREE.

GIBRALTAR, by Echo; Echo, by Rysdyk's Hambletonian; Echo the sire of Belle Echo, record 2:20; Gibraltar 2:23 1/2; Victor 2:23 1/2; Senator 2:23 1/2; El Monte 2:23, Col. Hawkins 2:23 1/2; Kenora 2:23 1/2; Sam Lewis 2:24 1/2 and the sire of the dams of a good many horses with records better than 2:20.

GIBRALTAR is the sire of Homestake, trial 2:15; half 1:08; Roxanna, trial 2:15; Doris, a 4 year old mare, son three times in one week, the first and only races that she ever started in and got a record of 2:19 in the seventh heat of the last race. Gibraltar is a great producer all his colts are good size and all look alike. They are natural trotters and all have got good dispositions.

### ALPHA.

ALPHA will make the Season same as Gibraltar. Term, \$25 for the Season with privilege of return or \$30 to insure a foal. You will see that ALPHA is a very fine bred horse. Buccaneer public trial at 4 years old 2:24 1/2 and Prompter record 2:33 1/2 (sire of Transit 3-year-old record 2:25 1/2, Creole record 5th heat 2:31 1/2, Daisy 2:33 1/2 and fastest record in the world for a yearling pacer); 3d dam Lady Hake by John the Baptist, record of 2:45, son of Tallyho Morgan, by Sherman Morgan, he by Justin Morgan; 4th dam Fanny Fern by Tuckahoe, by Herod's Tuckahoe, by Tuckahoe; 5th dam by Lettler's Consul, son of Swooper's Consul, by Bon's Just Consul. Grand dam by Imported Messenger. The dam of Privateer was Lady Nairy, dam of Empress 2:29 1/2, by Marion, son of Mambrino Chief; 2d dam by John Bull of Old Bull, by old pacing Pilot sire of Pilot. Grand sire of dams of Mandrake, Jay Eye See, Marion's dam was Mary, by Sir Wallace, son of Stockholder by Tempest. Buccaneer's dam was Tinsley Maid by Flaxtail. Tinsley Maid is a full sister to Fern Leaf, dam of Good Leaf, 3-year-old record 2:28 1/2; Shamrock, 2-year-old record 2:25 and of Lightfoot, 4-year-old record 2:32, and who in turn is dam of Pride, yearling record 2:40 1/2. Lightfoot is also dam of Pearl 2:33 1/2. Iowa Chief's dam was Topsey by Prompter, son of Hill's Black Hawk by Sherman's Morgan by Justin Morgan. Green's Bashaw's dam was Belle by Peffer's Tom Thumb out of the Charles Kent mare, the dam of Rysdyk's Hambletonian and she out of One Eye by Bishop's Hambletonian son of Imported Messenger, and One Eye out of Silverball by Imported Messenger.
