THE LAW A DEAD LETTER.

The APPEAL is informed that Commissioner Bray makes no defense of his course as exposed by this journal yesterday, but says: 'I'll take all the contracts I please, and the APPEAL can't stop me.' If Mr. Bray used this language, he out of his own mouth, demonstrates more than anything the APPEAL can say, his utter unfitness for the responsible office of County Commissioner. His defiance of the law comes from a feeling of perfect security born of the knowledge that the powerful ring behind him will see that the law will be made a dead letter in his case.

As long as Sardis Summerfield is District Attorney, as long as Tremore Coffin can handle the pulls on the Grand Jury, and as long as the Grand Jury can be drawn under the present method, Bray is all right, and the law might as well be wiped from the Statute book as far as he is concerned.

The law was placed there to prevent county officers profiting from their official positions and passing on their own bills. But Bray has defied the law as well as broken it, and by being a County Commissioner he has been able to freeze out the other draymen in this city, who pay a license for a protection they don't get, and are citizens and taxpayers.

That one man can run another out of business because of his official position, is not contemplated by the law, and if one law cannot be enforced in Ormsby, the rest might as well be wiped off the Statute books and Ormsby county be placed on a par with the strip of lawless country in the West called 'No Man's Land,' a territory claimed by no State, by reason of a surveyor's blunder, where lawbreakers of all grades are herded and allowed to do as they please.

A species of terrorism has been exerted over the citizens of Ormsby for years, and the community has been cowed by the feeling that a clique of men possess some mysterious pull which enables them to crush out anyone who opposes their little schemes.

Now this pull is all moonshine; they merely have certain officials under their thumbs, and they make people believe that it is their backing which alone elects candidates to office in Ormsby.

As long as they can fill the official with this idea they own him, body and soul. They have been unable to put the collar on the APPEAL and when a little over a year ago this journal announced that it would not allow murderers, petit larceny thieves and fraudulent bankrupts to be crammed down its throat, it was notified that it must get in line or it would be run out of town.

It did not get in line nor will it be run out of town. It will labor in behalf of the better element of taxpayers in this city and rid Ormsby county of the incubus of boodlesism which have been fastened on it and in its fight for a law-abiding county government it expects the assistance, irrelative of party, of all decent, law abiding citizens.

Threats and blustering talk will have no effect. The only way the APPEAL can be successfully fought on this proposition is by disproving its statements.

It was not many years ago that the same sort of a ring got its clutches on the county Treasury and the people rose up and stamped the ring out of existence at the polls. This is the true method of handling the proposition.
