

THE NEW DEAL.

Ormsby county is now governed by a new Board of County Commissioners and a new set of county officers.

This is the first time in many years that the county has not been under Republican rule.

The change was the result of the political cyclone that swept the county at the last election.

The people became tired of the same men enjoying the public trusts, the same hands pulling the strings and the same officers always directing affairs.

They became aware that certain men who were enjoying positions of public trust, were betraying the taxpayers and using their positions for their own benefit, and that matters were being run in defiance of the law.

The APPEAL pointed out to the public where the law was constantly violated and the free and independent voters of this county did the rest.

How much better the new officers will prove than the old, is something which can only be decided by a fair trial. If they stick to the plain provisions of the statutes and bear in mind that they do not own the offices, but are only public servants whose retention in office depends entirely on their honest conduct of affairs, they will be asked to serve the people a second time.

The APPEAL, while it supported the present incumbents in the election, reserves the right, as it always has, to call public attention to violations of law on the part of any official.

The disposition of party organs to overlook crooked work on the part of public officials of their own party is the root of most of the evils for which the public suffers in the way of official corruption.

The idea that only a certain class of people are capable of managing public affairs is all rot, and in a few weeks everything will be running smoothly.

It is an injustice to some of the outgoing officers to class them with the corrupt and incompetent; the ring known as the Court House Ring did not include all of the county officials, some of whom were as faithful and honest as could be found anywhere.

It was a case where the innocent suffered with the guilty. The people wanted a change and got it.

It is the duty of every good citizen to assist in making the county Administration of the coming two years one which will be alike creditable to the administration, and satisfactory to the taxpayers.
