An S. F. Bank Robbery.
San Francisco, Feb. 19.—Three
men entered a Market street bank, a
small institution in the Spreckels
building, shortly after 10 o'clock this
morning and ordered Cashier Hop-
kins and Bookkeeper Wayhurst to hold
up their hands. Hopkins, who was
at the counter, refused and one rob-
ber fired a bullet, passing his head
but not striking either official. The
three robbers then climbed through a
hole in the wire screen at the cashier's
window and seized the two bank
officials and hustled them into the
vault.

A piece of the carpet caught in the
door of the vault and the robbers did
not take time to fasten the vault door.
Hastily dumping a pile of gold on
the cashier's counter into a sack,
they escaped. Although Market
street was crowded with passing peo-
ple, the robbers made good their es-
cape. It is supposed that they secured
only \$800.

Governor Juarez on his ear.
El Paso, Feb. 11.—The Governor of
Juarez says: "If the fighters meet on
Mexican soil I will arrest the prin-
ciples, betters, spectators and news-
paper reporters and not one will es-
cape three years imprisonment."

Washington, Feb. 18.—In the House

Committee to inquire what effect the

and silver standard countries has
upon the manufacturing industries of
the United States. The Pacific Coast
he said was now threatened with an
invasion of the cheap labor of Ori-
ental countries, and an increase in the
price of silver would take from the
Oriental countries the advantage they
now possess.

Mixed Social Affairs.
Providence, (R. I.) February 18.—
The authorities have discovered that
the new law requiring all persons
performing the marriage ceremony to
register yearly is identical with one
enacted seventy years ago, which has
long been a dead letter. The author-
ities state there has not been a legal
marriage in Rhode Island for fifty
years and will apply to the Legisla-
ture to have all acts of unlicensed
clergymen made valid.

Married a Prince.
Charlottesville, Va., Feb. 17.—Ann-
Eliza Chandler and Prince Pierre
Trocheyev, a Russian nobleman,
were married this afternoon at Castle
Hill, home of her father. The couple
will sail tomorrow for London, where
they will reside.
