Excitement in Italy.
Rome, March 4.—The kingdom of Italy is today in a condition of excitement, grief and anger at the disaster to the Italian army in Abyssinia. It is now believed that 5,000 Italian soldiers were killed yesterday by Abyssinians. Demonstrations against the Government and even against the King are being made in almost every town in Italy. The Government is blamed for the bad management of the campaign and for allowing Gen. Baratieri, who was in command of the troops, to expose them to needless slaughter.
Premier Crispi has resigned, but the King refused to accept his resignation. At noon today it was announced that General Baratieri had been recalled and would be court-martialed. The Socialists demanded that Baratieri and the Minister of War be shot as examples. Twenty-eight battalions and fourteen batteries have been ordered to Abyssinia as reinforcements.

Holmes Will Hang.
Philadelphia, March 4.—The Supreme Court today, in a decision by Justice Williams, overruled all assignments of error in the case of H. H. Holmes, sentenced to death for murdering Benjamin F. Pitel, and confirmed the judgment of the Court below. The opinion says that no substantial error has been pointed out, and that the evidence fully sustained the verdict. Governor Hastings, it is believed, will fix an early day for the execution. Holmes is said to have recently sent for a Catholic priest, who visited him several times.

A Bully in the Senate.
Richmond, Va., March 4.—Senator Flood entered the Senate chamber this afternoon and walking up to Senator Flannigan belabored him over the head with a cane, inflicting painful but not dangerous wounds. Flood was arrested. The assault was provoked by the fact that Flannigan, a day or two ago, said on the floor that Flood had falsified him.
