**GOVERNMENT WAKES UP**

The Chinese boycott has finally reached the dignity of international inquiry. The United States Government has made official representations to the Chinese, and has demanded that American treaty rights be kept inviolate. There is no question as to the attitude of the Chinese Government in the matter. There will be no "official recognition" of the boycott. The Chinese are adepts in the art of diplomacy, and when it comes to proving that the Chinese people are keeping within their rights, the Orientals will have all the evidence.

There is no law, either local, national or international, that will compel any one to buy goods that he does not want. Neither is there any law to compel people to work when they don't want to, except the law of personal necessity.

But the Chinese now have the boycott where they want it, and while it is sifting through the slow channels of diplomacy there will be sufficient agitation to keep the matter alive before the minds of the people whom it is hoped to influence and all the pressure that can be brought to bear on the national lawmakers will be centered on the effort to have the exclusion law abrogated.

With our Government making "official" inquiries and the Chinese making "official" replies, there will be plenty of argument advanced in favor of the abrogation of the treaty, without any one having an opportunity of arguing on the other side.

A rather unusual use of the power of injunction has been made by an Iowa woman who enjoyed her would-be son-in-law from marrying her daughter. She also enjoined the young man from buying clothes for the girl or supplying her with money pending the time when she should be old enough to marry him without her mother's consent. If that wedding takes place it will be an indication that Iowa men are not afraid of their wife's mother.
