FOCUS AND FOCI

Explanation of Their Meanings as Used in Fever Reports by New Orleans Papers.

For the benefit of those who may be in doubt as to the meaning of the words focus and foci as used by the New Orleans papers in reporting the fever situation, the following explanation is given.

Focus, plural foci, is used to designate a place where fever has developed. A new focus means that the fever has appeared in a new place, that is in a house not previously containing a case of fever; 16 new foci means that yellow fever has been found in 16 houses which up to that time had no fever cases.

FEVER SITUATION

Latest Official Report of Health Authorities. Figures Given Out by Marine Hospital Service.

The following is the official yellow fever report for New Orleans for the twenty-four hours ending Monday at 6 p. m.

Deaths..... 5 Cases..... 45 Foci..... 18

This makes the totals thus far: Deaths..... 260 Total cases..... 1,788 Up to 12 o'clock yesterday 20 new cases and five deaths were reported.

Five new cases in Patterson were announced yesterday with 7 additional on a plantation one mile from town. Only two deaths out of over 125 cases at Patterson so far.

Rayne has had only one case, and no secondary infection has followed.

Alexandria, Shreveport and Bon Ami are all clear of the fever.

A number of plantations in the sugar district are infected.
