### THE POLICE JURY.

Second ward five dollars per month payable quarterly.  
Fourth ward, four and 16-2-3 dollars per month payable quarterly.  
Fifth ward seven and 50-100 dollars per month payable quarterly.  
Sixth ward seven and 50-100 dollars per month payable quarterly.  
Seventh ward three and 33 and 1-3 dollars, justice of the peace per month payable quarterly.  
Seventh ward three and 75-100 dollars, constable per month payable quarterly.  
Eighth ward four dollars per month payable quarterly.  
Mr. Martin reported the road from Mrs. Edgar Martin to Mouton Switch not as yet completed, and submitted acts of donation of land for wards as follows which was accepted and ordered recorded at the clerk's office:  
From Mrs. Emile Mouton to Jules Patin, from Gaston Francez gin to Lafayette-Carencro public road, from Louis Martin to Francois Arceneaux, all in the third ward.

Mr. Landry stated that he wished to again bring up the matter of the Police Jury making a small appropriation in aid of the proposed parish fair to be held in October; that at the last meeting a motion to that effect was lost, he believed, for he reason that some of the members thought it was too late to undertake the giving of a parish fair this year; that by diligent work of the committees on parish fair the undertaking was now an assured thing and since, in his opinion, it would mean innumerable good to the people of the parish he would ask that the Police Jury make an appropriation to whatever amount it may deem proper.

Mr. Martin explained that he had opposed, at the last regular meeting the motion offered to appropriate \$200 in aid of the parish fair because he felt that the parish of Lafayette should contribute more than \$200 for such a good cause, and that at this time the parish was not financially able to make the appropriation it should for a fair in this parish, but that since it was shown that the fair was assured and that \$200 would be

of great help to the fair association he moved to appropriate \$200, and seconded by Mr. Voorhies, the motion was duly carried.
