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ENGLISH COAST TOWNS IN CONSTANT DREAD OF BEING AGAIN ATTACKED BY FLEET

Correspondence of the Associated Press. West Hartlepool, Dec. 18.—English east coast towns are panic-stricken since the German raid upon Scarborough, Whitby and the Hartlepoons. Confidence in the power of the British navy to keep the Germans away from England has weakened and there is constant dread of the reappearance of German troops.

The patrol ships Patrol and Doon, which guard Hartlepool, were lying in the harbor the morning of the German raid, but are said by civilians to have had no steam. It is also charged they were partly dismantled and had to be towed out of the docks before they could get into any action.

An investigation of the navy's action has been demanded by mayors of the ruined towns and the result of the prospective inquiry by the Admiralty is awaited impatiently along the east coast which no longer goes to sleep at night with a feeling of security.

FEDERAL INCOME TAX LAW SCORED BY WISCONSIN MAN

T. S. Adams Says Measure Promotes Class Conflict and Public Extravagance—Should Not Be Imposed Upon the Poor

Princeton, N. J., Dec. 30.—The federal income tax, for which only 357,598 returns were received last year, is reaching directly less than one-half of one per cent. of the population.

"The present federal income tax is a class tax and class taxes breed extravagance," he said. "It deserves approval from almost every other standpoint, but in this respect it needs courageous correction."

"If swollen fortunes are bad, they should be attacked directly and the cause removed. To let them accumulate and then tax them 10 per cent. smacks of hypocrisy, and the attempt to make the income tax do the work of social reform is apt to spoil the income tax."
