SHAH IS ASSASSINATED

Shot by a Revolutionary Fanatic Near Teheran.

THE MURDERER AT ONCE ARRESTED

As the Shah of Persia Enters the Inner Court of the Shrine, the Assassin, Disguised as a Woman, Fires Upon Him, the Bullet Entering the Region of the Heart—The Heir Apparent at Once Notified of the Sad Occurrence.

TEHRAN, Persia, May 2.—While the shah was entering the inner court of the shrine of Shah Abdul Azim, six miles south of this city, Friday afternoon, he was shot and mortally wounded.

Immediately after the shah was shot he was carried to his carriage and in it conveyed to the palace in this city.

SECRETARY O'NEIL NOTIFIED. WASHINGTON, May 2.—The following cablegram was received by Secretary O'Neil at 2:40 o'clock Friday afternoon from United States Minister McDonald at Teheran, Persia: "Shah visiting shrine near the city Thursday for devotion, upon entering the inner sanctuary was shot by an assassin disguised as a woman, the bullet entering the region of the heart. He expired within two hours. Fratricide a revolutionary fanatic. Great distress, but city quiet."

THE NEWS IN BERLIN. BERLIN, May 2.—According to a dispatch received here from Teheran the Shah of Persia was shot and killed Friday afternoon while entering the shrine of Shah Abdul Azim. It is added that a physician attached to the German legation saw the shah's body.
