TEXAS NEWS BRIEFS.

The Texas auto association was formed at San Antonio.

The Commission form of government was voted down at Orange.

The annual convention of the southwestern Ice Manufacturers opened at San Antonio.

The Twelfth annual convention of

the Texas Federation of Women's clubs began at Denison.

Officers and directors were elected at the annual meeting of the Texas company at Port Arthur.

A penitentiary commission was proposed by part of the investigating committee to take over control of the penal institutions.

In an opinion by the attorney general's department a city can not by bond issues aid or further interests of a private enterprise.
