BATTLE IS IMMINENT NEAR TOWN IN TEXAS

PIEDRAS NEGRAS FEDERALS, OPPOSITE EAGLE PASS, DRAW UP TO MEET REBELS.

Eagle Pass, Tex., Nov. 6.—All the Federal troops under Colonel Alvarez in Piedras Negras were drawn up in battle formation late today apparently to resist any attack on the part of Constitutionalists now camped on the outskirts of the city. Reports received by the American military authorities indicate that the federalists are in no position to engage in offensive operations. Couriers from the Constitutionalists returned at 5 o'clock to obtain news of the developments at the City of Mexico. It is not thought likely that an attack will be made until the Constitutional officers have had a chance to analyze the news.
