EXPLOSION OF AN ENGINE

TWO MEN KILLED AND ONE PROBABLY FATALY HURT.

Accident Occurred at Fisher.—Katy Train Came Over Cotton Belt Last Night.

At 5 o'clock yesterday afternoon a locomotive on the Katy track at Fisher, a little station seven miles this side of Dallas, burst its boiler with a terrific explosion.

In consequence of the accident the northbound Limited and the mail train were sent here over the Cotton Belt track reaching this place at 1:15 in the morning.

NEW SERVICE ON KATY

NIGHT TRAIN BETWEEN DALLAS AND SAN ANTONIO.

Katy Limited Will Reach St. Louis at More Convenient Hour.

Dallas, Tex., Dec. 12.—Executive January 1, additions to the M. K. & T. service in the way of new trains are announced by W. G. Crush, general passenger agent.

The night service between Waco and Oklahoma City will consist of standard sleeping cars between Waco and Oklahoma City.

Probably the most interesting in the schedule to Dallas people is that of the Katy Limited from Dallas north bound.

The daylight train between Waco and San Antonio will leave Waco at 7 a. m., Austin about 11:30 a. m., arriving in San Antonio about 1:20 p. m., arriving in Waco about 9 p. m.

Trains No. 1, which now leaves Dallas at 6:25 p. m. and stops at Waco, will, on the new card, leave Dallas at 7:15 p. m. and run through to Houston and San Antonio arriving at the latter points about the same time, 6:20 a. m.

Speaking this morning of the proposed improvements, Mr. Crush said: "The extensive improvements the M. K. & T. intends to put into effect on the first of the year, are caused by the greatly increased travel. One matter of interest to Dallas people and the traveling public generally is the fact that diners are to be put on the Katy Limited to St. Louis."

The arrival in St. Louis an hour earlier is also a distinct advantage to the traveling public. For strangers coming here and intending to visit the theater or other places of amusement it gives ample time for preparation.

It permits a man who lives in St. Louis to get home to his dinner. I wish to impress on the public the fact that the Texas service will be composed of strictly first class trains.

ONE MAN IS IN JAIL

QUADRUPLE MURDER IN KANSAS SLOWLY BEING UNRAVELED.

Bloody Garments Found in House of John Feagle—He Was Arrested Yesterday.

Kansas City, Dec. 12.—A bloody pair of overalls and shirt were found by Chief of Police Zimmer of Kansas City, Kansas, today, in the home of John Feagle, who was arrested yesterday in connection with the quadruple murder on the Barnhardt farm in Johnson county, Kan., last week.

The bloody garments were concealed in a closet on the second floor of Feagle's home.

Arrest Made by Officers. Kansas City, Mo., Dec. 12.—John Feagle, a hunter and trapper whose home is one-half mile west of the Barnhardt farm in Johnson county, Kansas, where Mrs. Emily Barnhardt, George Barnhardt, her son, Thomas H. Morgan and James Graves, were murdered, was arrested in connection with the crime early today and placed in the Kansas City, Kan., jail.

WHITE IS CHIEF JUSTICE

PRESIDENT TAFT FILLS VACANCIES ON SUPREME BENCH.

Personnel of New Rate Tribunal Announced—No Texas in List of Appointees.

Washington, Dec. 12.—President Taft sent to the Senate today the following nominations:

Chief Justice Supreme Court, Justice Edward White, Louisiana, now Associate Justice.

Associate Justice Supreme Court, Willis Van Dyke, Wyoming, now Judge Joseph Lamar, Georgia.

Judges new Court of Commerce, Martin A. Knapp, now chairman of the Interstate Commerce Commission, for term of five years; Robert Archibald, now United States District Judge, Middle District, Pennsylvania, for term of four years; William H. Holt, now Judge of Customs Appeals, formerly United States District Judge, District of Montana, term three years.

Judge Carlisle, South Dakota, term two years; Julian Mack, now Judge of the Appellate Circuit Court of the First Illinois District, term one year.

To be collector of Internal Revenue, District of Oklahoma, George Knott, Oklahoma, now. Holt, now Judge of the Supreme Court, term one year.

The nomination of Chief Justice White was confirmed by the Senate shortly after it was received by this city.

Judge Carlisle of South Dakota is a Democrat. His appointment makes the complexion of the Commerce Court three Republicans and two Democrats.

TRAGEDY IN A SALOON

DEAD MAN AND HIS SLAYER NOT RELATED BUT NAMES SIMILAR.

Walks Into Office of Mr. Brandenburg and Remarked, "I Had To Do It."

Dallas, Tex., Dec. 12.—Following a fight in the saloon of V. A. Cook on Elm street this afternoon shortly after 2 o'clock W. H. Cook a furniture man, was shot and almost instantly killed. Immediately following the shooting V. A. Cook, who runs the saloon, boarded a car with the remark that he would go down and surrender. A few minutes later he appeared at the sheriff's office and walking up to Sheriff Brandenburg, said: "I regret what I have just done, but I had to do it." He then told Sheriff Brandenburg that he had just killed a man and asked that he be locked up. He was taken to the county jail.

The remains of W. H. Cook were taken in charge by Undertaker Loughmiller. An examination at this place developed that two bullets had taken effect one in the left temple and the other entered near the mouth.

Cook, before leaving, the place of business for the purpose of surrendering, stated that he had to shoot the man. Assistant Chief of Police Lane, the sergeant in charge of the officers. When they reached the scene of the killing Cook was practically dead and the men who did the shooting had disappeared.

The dead man lived at 186 Bryan street. He is survived by a wife, a daughter and one son.

V. A. Cook, it is said, lived on Commerce street and was married. The two men are not related, it is said.

Latest Advices Say All the Passengers on the Boat Have Been Saved.

Seattle, Wash., Dec. 12.—Nothing has been heard today from the steamer Olympia which went on the rocks on the southeastern end of Dutch Island, Prince William Sound, Alaska, during a heavy storm yesterday. One hundred and six persons are aboard. Steamers and launches are hurrying to aid the vessel from Seaward, Valdez and Ketchikan.

The last word from the wireless operator before communication was broken was that the passengers and crew were still aboard. The vessel, which was being pounded and tossed on sharp rocks.
