



The Stock Law.

The test case on the violation of the stock law that was on file in the Justice court at Shiner, was a flash in the pan. According to the attorneys, who are supposed to be posted on the law, the case had to be dismissed for the reasons:

First, because the complaint must allege that there was an election held and give date of same and that the election was carried for the law.

Second, it must describe the metes and bounds throughout the entire county where the election was held.

Third, the county clerk must attend the trial with the county records and certify under oath to the foregoing facts.

All this notwithstanding these facts have already been certified to by the county judge and the commissioners' court, and have been established as a fact for over a year. If this reasoning could be carried far enough the same proceedings might be called

for on every law on the statute books. When a law has been duly and legally established, as has this law, it should be accepted as a fact and not require any further proof. How much longer will these technicalities be permitted to stand in the way of the enforcement of our laws?
