## JAPAN GETS FIRST BLOOD

Rammed Three Ships of Russia's Fleet With Torpedoes---Report Is Official.

St. Petersburg, Feb. 9.—An official dispatch received here says Japan's torpedo boats attacked the Russian squadron in the outer roads at Port Arthur, and three of the Russian ships were damaged.

Admiral Alexiff, Russian Viceroy of the Far East, confirms the above report, and says two of the ships damaged are battleships, the third a cruiser.

It is reported that eleven Japanese and one Russian warship had been sunk in attacks at Port Arthur this afternoon. Imperial court and all functionary are in solemn dum to pray for Russian victory.

London, 11 a. m.—Japanese Minister announces departure of Japanese fleet for Relow. Says Russia is making desperate effort to have powers intervene. Russia is now willing to concede everything he says, but offer comes too late.

New York, Feb. 9.—Latest advices here is that the Japanese are now bombarding Port Arthur.

## JAPAN HAS SEIZED RUSSIAN SHIPS

London, Feb. 8.—A special dispatch from Berlin says a strong fleet of Japanese war ships, reported to be on the way to Chemulpo, Korea, have seized several Russian Trading steamers.
