The first meeting was held in Ragsdale hall Wednesday morning at 10 o'clock and an interesting program of addresses and music was carried out.

The old soldiers were given a carriage ride over and around our city yesterday afternoon and were very favorably impressed with our town and country.

The veterans were entertained last night at the hall by the Daughters of Confederacy, a program consisting of readings, songs and musical selections was carried out and thoroughly enjoyed. The hall was packed with people.

They meet again this morning at the hall and will repair at noon to the grove west of W. H. Sory's residence in southwest Jacksonville, where a basket dinner will await them. The session will close today.

This has been one of the best reunions in the history of the brigade and the old soldiers are highly pleased with their reception at the hands of our citizens.

The Alto band furnished music for the occasion and proved themselves to be good musicians as well as a gentlemanly set of young men.—Jacksonville Reformer.

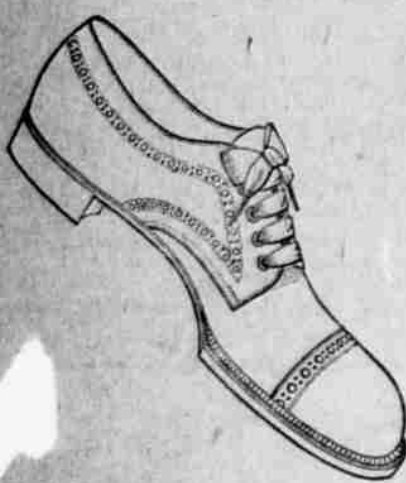
