Election Proclamation.

Under and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the City Council of the city of Palestine, it is hereby ordered:

That an election be held on the 10th day of November, 1905, for the purpose of submitting to the property tax-paying voters of said city the following proposition to-wit:

That the City Council of the said city of Palestine do issue bonds of said city for the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars, said bonds to bear interest from date of issuance until paid at the rate of four and one-half cents per annum, interest payable semi-annually, and to be payable forty years after date of issuance, the city reserving the right to take up said bonds after ten years from date of same. Said bonds to be issued and the money derived from the sale of same to be used for the purpose of building a new school house in the fourth ward, Ten Thousand Five Hundred Dollars. For addition to school house in second ward, Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars. For addition to school house in first ward, Five Thousand Dollars. That the voting places for said election shall be as follows:

For the first ward at the Court House, with S. P. Allen as presiding officer. For the second ward at the Recorder's office in City Hall, with W. H. Kingsbury as presiding officer. For the third ward at the East Fire Hall, with Chas. Jacobs as presiding officer. For the fourth ward at Compress office, with Wm. Persons as presiding officer. And that this order and notice be published in the official paper of the city of Palestine for not less than thirty days prior to said day of election, viz: November the 10th A. D., 1905.
