For the 3rd Ward at the Railroad Young Men's Christian Association Building, and Charles Jacobs is hereby appointed as presiding officer of said ward voting place.

For the 4th Ward at the office of the Old Compress in 4th Ward, and S. A. Taylor is hereby appointed as presiding officer of said ward voting place.

That this order and notice be published in one or more newspapers of said city for not less than 30 days prior to said day of election.

Section 1. That whereas, it has been shown to the satisfaction of the qualified voters, residing upon and within the territory hereinafter described have in accordance with the law expressed a desire to have said territory to become a part of the City of Palestine, and it further appearing to the satisfaction of the City Council that said territory adjoining the said corporation and is one-half mile wide, being described by meets and bounds as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the s. w. corner of the present Fourth Ward addition; thence south to the prolongation of the west line of said addition 1100 feet to corner; thence west 2640 feet to stake for corner; thence north to the s. w. corner of the Nelsmith and Bordeaux addition; thence east with the south line of same to the s. e. corner, a point in the west line of the Fourth Ward addition; thence south with said line to place of beginning.

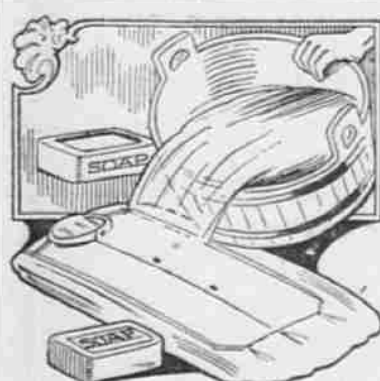
