News Item.

The Fort Worth & Denver City Railway Company, popularly known as "The Denver Road," announces that, effective June first, it will establish a new through sleeping car line between Lafayette, La., and Denver, Colo., the routing of same to be via the lines of the Southern Pacific Company between Lafayette and Houston, the H. & T. C. road between Houston and Fort Worth, and "The Denver Road" between Fort Worth and Denver. This is a new feature in favor of the satisfactory accommodation of a constantly increasing tourist business to Colorado, and will undoubtedly serve with favor and tend to increase such tourist business from Louisiana and Southern Texas points; also from points in Central Texas along the line of the H. & T. C. road.

In addition to the foregoing, announcement is made that double daily train service will be again established via the F. W. & D. C. Ry. through to Denver about June 1st, and that in all likelihood a third train will be placed in service for the accommodation of local business between Fort Worth and Quanah, Texas.

With the inauguration of this third train it is understood the schedules of the through Colorado trains will be materially quickened or shortened, since the local train referred to will make it possible to cut out a number of stops en route which have been necessary to the through trains during former seasons.
