LEGAL NOTICES.

AN ORDINANCE

Providing for holding an election in the City of Palestine, Texas, by the property tax-paying voters of said City; to determine by their votes whether the City Council of said City shall be authorized to issue the bonds of said City to the following amounts and for the following purposes, to-wit:

TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS for the purpose of paving Oak street between Avenue "A" and Tennessee Avenue, and North Sycamore, Palmer, John and Line streets between Oak street and Main street; and

TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS for the purpose of paving Avenue "A" from Sycamore street to Church street; all bonds payable forty years after their date, redeemable at the option of the City at any time after ten years from their date; the same to bear interest from date of issue until paid at the rate of Four per cent per annum, payable semi-annually; and to levy a tax sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds and to create a sinking fund sufficient to redeem them at maturity; designating election officers and polling places and prescribing the form of official ballots.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALESTINE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That an election shall be held in the City of Palestine, Texas, on the 20th day of August, 1907, for the purpose of submitting to the property tax-paying voters of said City the following propositions, to-wit:

1. Shall the City Council of the City of Palestine, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the amounts and for the purposes hereinafter stated, payable forty years from their date, redeemable at the option of the said City at any time after Ten years after their date, bearing interest at the rate of Four per cent per annum, payable semi-annually; and to levy a tax sufficient to pay the interest thereon and create a sinking fund sufficient to redeem them at their maturity:

1. Bonds to the amount of TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS for the purpose of paving Oak street between Avenue "A" and Tennessee Avenue, and Sycamore, Palmer, John and Line streets between Oak street and Main street.

2. Bonds to the amount of TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS for the purpose of paving Avenue "A" between Sycamore street and Church street.

Section 2. Said election shall be held in all the wards of said city of Palestine, each of which is hereby constituted an election precinct for said election, at the places hereinafter designated and by the officers hereinafter named, who are hereby appointed to hold said election in their respective precincts:

Election precinct No. 1 (First Ward): Polling place at the County Court House; Presiding Judge, J. D. Moore; Assistant Judge, J. J. Wood; Clerks, C. G. Wagner and P. E. Price.

Election precinct No. 2 (Second Ward): Polling place at the Recorder's Office in the City Hall; Presiding Judge, Jno. Batton; Assistant Judge, W. C. Fleet; Clerks, M. B. Welborn and Jno. Townsend.

Election precinct No. 3 (Third Ward): Polling place at Broyles' Mill Office; Presiding Judge, Chas. Jacobs; Assistant Judge, Jim Mears; Clerks, J. F. Watson and Horace Wood.

Election precinct No. 4 (Fourth Ward): Polling place at Fourth Ward School House; Presiding Judge, W. G. McGuire; Assistant Judge, S. L. Lucas; Clerks, Fred Lyne and Ed W. Williams.

Section 3. The said election shall be held under the provisions of Chapter 149, of the Acts of the 26th Legislature, and only qualified voters who are property tax-payers of said City shall be allowed to vote. All voters desiring to support the proposition to issue \$25,000.00 of bonds for the purpose of paving Oak street between Avenue "A" and Tennessee Avenue, and Sycamore, Palmer, John and Line streets between Oak street and Main street shall have printed upon their ballots the words: "For issuance of Bonds for paving Oak, Sycamore, Palmer, John and Line streets;" and those persons who oppose the issuance of said bonds shall have printed on their ballots the words: "Against the issuance of bonds for paving Oak, Sycamore, Palmer, John and Line streets"; and all voters desiring to support the proposition for issuing \$25,000.00 of bonds for the purpose of paving Avenue "A" between Sycamore and Church streets shall have printed upon their ballots the words: "For 'A'"; and those opposed shall have printed upon their ballots the words: "Against the issuance of Bonds for paving Avenue 'A'."

The manner of holding said election shall be governed by the laws of the State regulating General Elections. A copy of this ordinance, signed by the Mayor of said City, shall serve as a proper notice of said election, and the Mayor is directed to cause said notice to be posted up at each of the places designated for holding said election, and to cause the same to be published in a newspaper published in the City for fully 30 days prior to the date of said election.
