An Ordinance making it unlawful for any person, firm or corporation of persons to maintain any wooden stairway in any part of any alley, running from Spring street to the south margin of Crawford street, between Tenenessee Avenue and Avenue A on Spring, Main and Oak streets and between Line and Syca-more on Crawford street; also all iron, tin and wooden structures of any kind whatsoever in the rear of all business houses, fronting southon Spring and Main and Oak be-tween Avenue A and Tennesee Ave-nue. All such structures being condemned and declared to be nui-sances and shall be considered unlawful and must be abated from and after the passage and publication of this Ordinance.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Palestine, Texas: Section 1. That it shall hereafter be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation of persons to maintain any wooden stairway in any part of any alley, running from Spring street to Crawford street, between Tennessee Avenue and Avenue A on Spring, Main and Oak streets, and between Line and North Sycamore on Craw-

ford street. Section 2. It shall hereafter be unlawful to maintain any iron, tin or wooden structure of any kind whatsoever in the rear of any business house fronting on Spring and Main streets, between Avenue A and Tennessee Avenue, and Oak street between Line and North Sycamore street. Section 3. All of the above describ-

ed structures in the above-named places are hereby condemned and declared to be nuisances and any person guilty of maintaining any such nultf sances after the passage and publica-Are you dull and stupid?
