### AUTOS REQUIRED TO CARRY STATE TAG

Oklahoma City, June 17.—On the stroke of midnight Monday a new era in road administration will be ushered in Oklahoma, as on Tuesday the new road law will go into effect.

The state highway department will be reorganized and county commissioners will take hold of organizing a state and county highway system which when completed will give Oklahoma the most complete system of highways in the union.

The new law provides ways and means for the raising of nearly six million dollars annually as the county levy has been increased from 5 to 3 mills for road purposes. The state will aid every county which levies a special quarter of a mill tax by giving them a like amount. Means have been provided for dragging the roads by contract and convict labor can be secured by counties at a minimum expense.

The tribute of the auto owners to the road fund of the state will, during the first eighteen months, reach the half million mark, as for the first month 25 cents per horse power will be paid, and for the full year, 50 cents per horse power. With approximately 50,000 motor driven articles, including traction engines and motorcycles in the state, it will be seen that the horse power will reveal enormous power being used on the highways.

Although the law provides for a graduated tax each year the first license under the law will call for 50 cents per horse power, regardless of the age of the car. The law reads that after the first license of 50 cents per horse power has been taken out on any motor vehicle, that the second shall cost 40 cents, the third 30 cents, and 20 cents ever afterwards while the car is in use. Only one tag shall be carried on the car and that the one furnished by the state highway department and it must be stationary and not swinging.

Application for the license tag must be made by the auto owner to the state highway department and the information given must be sworn to before tag is issued. These forms will be retained as a part of the records of the state and will bear the same number as the tag issued.

The A. L. & A. M. formula is to govern the amount to be paid. As this rating is always lower than the advertised horse power it will be necessary for all owners to secure correct data in this regard. The formula is based on the bore of the cylinder, on a ratio of one thousand cylinder feet per minute and will be furnished by the department so that it will be easy to determine the proper rating. In some few instances the advertised horse power is lower and occasionally the same, the latter particularly in the high priced car—and strangely enough the Ford car, advertised at 20 horse power is rated at 22 A. L. & A. M. The department of highway, however, has on hand a book containing every known make and model with the two rates given so that all information will be available at the proper time.

There will be no more city tags issued to private owners, but there is nothing in the law prohibiting municipalities from licensing livery cars or providing traffic ordinances. The law, however, lays down general rules of the road which are also available at the highway department.

The funds received from the auto license is disbursed as follows: Ten per cent goes to the state treasury and the other 90 per cent to the counties from which it is collected. Of that amount 25 per cent goes to cities of the first class and those under the commission form of government from which auto money is collected. Automobiles are exempt from any kind of taxation apart from the license by the state.
