**Treatment of Walls.** If a molding is liked from which to hang the pictures that do so much to make our rooms homelike, the best height for the molding is in line with the top of the doors. The modern idea seems to be to bring the window wood work to the floor by using a paneling beneath the sill, and to carry the top of doors and windows to a fixed line—the molding line. Thus the walls are divided into rectangular spaces, and the decorative effect of a good paper is enhanced. A plain paper has the dignity of a panel when so used.
