**Recording Losses Continues Feature**

(By The United Press.)  
 New York, Dec. 29.—Loss recording sales for cash continued a halting influence in the stock market today. The market, however, showed vigorous resistance and capacity to absorb sales at or above Thursday's closing levels. When the pressure eased in mid-afternoon, prices turned upward with the independent steels in the van. This group of stocks has been rather out of favor for sometime of poor earnings but trade reports recently have indicated the recovery in the steel industry is likely to continue the earnings statements for the next several quarters should be gratifying to holders of steel stocks. Although the full extent of the recovery will not be reflected in figures for this current quarter, practically all steel companies will show substantial balances for their common issues.

The extent of the recovery in industry during the past year was reflected in the department of commerce review which showed that output of manufactured goods had increased about fifty per cent over 1921. Increase in steel production was between sixty and seventy per cent and automobiles fifty per cent.
