COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

Caldwell, Idaho, Monday January 9th, 1904. The Board of County Commissioners of Canyon County, Idaho, met this day pursuant to law.

Present Commissioners, W. H. Platt, chairman, Robert McGuire and A. J. Breshears, and John A. Tucker, clerk, when the following proceedings were had:

David P. Dodd, Fred E. Fisk and John F. T. Bayse appeared before the Board for the purpose of qualifying as the Board of County Commissioners for this county for the ensuing term

Whereupon on motion, the bonds of David P. Dodd and Fred E. Fisk were approved and ordered filed. The bond of J. F. T. Bayse being furnished and secured by the Title Guarantee and Trust Company of Scranton, Penn., and the County Attorney having filed his written opinion that none of such bonding companies have complied with the requirements of the laws of the State of Idaho, therefore, on motion, the bond of the said John F. T. Bayse was rejected, and whereupon said John F. T. Bayse presented a personal bond which was approved and ordered filed.

Whereupon the County Recorder of this county administered the official oath to said David P. Dodd, Fred E. Fisk and John F. T. Bayse, and each of them, as County Commissioners of this county as required by law.

Whereupon the members of the new board proceeded to ballot for a Chairman of said board, and it appearing therefrom that Fred E. Fisk received a majority of the votes cast, it is therefore ordered that Fred E. Fisk be and he is hereby declared chairman of said board.

Whereupon, on motion, the official bonds of Jasper C. Nichols as Sheriff, Sumner W. Dee as treasurer, Sumner W. Dee as public administrator, Maxfield I. Church as probate judge, Cora B. Bean as superintendent of public instruction, W. Watkins as assessor and ex-officio tax collector, William Noot as Surveyor, Owen M. Van Duyn as prosecuting attorney, and William F. Loder as coroner, were approved and ordered filed, and thereupon the official oath was duly administered to each of them for their respective offices, by the chairman, as required by law.
