

THE TEXTILE STRIKE OFF.

Council at Lowell, Mass., Admits Can Not Win.

Lowell, Mass., June 23.—The textile council has declared the strike in the Lowell mills at an end. Every union affiliated with the council was represented and the vote was unanimous. Male spinners and loom fixers were included in this vote, despite statements that they would oppose a return to work. President Conroy later said: "We now worship at the altar of defeat, but later we shall rise again and conquer."

William H. Southworth, of the agents, said it would be impossible to start the remainder of the machinery so as to employ at once all who will come back, and added:

"It is for the selling agents and the treasurers to decide in view of the market whether we shall attempt to run in full."

The strike began on March 30 and involved about 1700 operatives. The mills were closed until June 1, when the agents opened the gates and the majority of the operatives went back to work. The strike has cost in wages about \$1,300,000. The high price of cotton precluded any hope of success of the strikers for a ten per cent increase.

No Change in Name.

Butte, Mont., June 25.—By a majority of two votes the Episcopal convocation of the district of Montana, now in session here, passed a resolution against changing the name of the church from "Episcopal" to "The American church."

Stench is Awful.

Heppner, Ore., June 24.—With the cleaning up of this city, which was two thirds destroyed by the horrible flood over a week ago, the stench has become unbearable. Diseases of many kinds are expected to break out at any time. As a result of this, men who still reside here are sending their families out of the city until the wreckage can be cleared away.

The worst odors came from vaults, cellars, wells and cess pools, which were filled with debris, mud and slime. Contrary to anticipations, no bodies were found in these places. The work of pumping out these places is nearly completed and disinfectants are placed in them as quickly as possible. Alkali dirt was used in most instances.

Telephone Men Strike.

San Francisco, June 25.—Over 1500 electrical linemen in the employ of the Pacific States Telephone & Telegraph company are out on a strike. Some of the linemen in California, Oregon, Washington and Arizona quit work to enforce demands for the adoption of an increased wage scale. The strike order was issued by electrical workers' union, No. 151.

RELIANCE WON AGAIN.

Took a Race From Columbia and Constitution.

New York.—The Reliance won the last race of the 90 foot sloops in Long Island sound in the first 20 minutes of sailing, and before turning the first mark, while the Columbia and Constitution were trying to outflank each other. By the sharp rivalry both the older boats lost hundreds of yards and any prospect they might have had of winning.

After that it was a procession all the way round to the finish line. The Reliance beat the Constitution by 4 minutes and 17 seconds and the Columbia by 7 minutes and 31 seconds.

The course was twice around a triangle, a reach of three miles across the sound and a four mile beat to windward and a broad reach of four and three-quarters miles, 23 1/2 miles in all.

When the trio rounded the last mark and made a straight course on a broad reach in a freshening breeze to the finish line the Reliance headed the pretty procession by more than half a mile and held her lead to the finish.

Colonel D. F. D. Neill, Sir Thomas Lipton's representative, after witnessing the race today, said:

"The Reliance is a fine boat. I have heard that her sails were not good and that she was going to have at Rately suit, but they are excellent. She does not need to change them in my opinion. I think we have a fairly good chance of winning."

Strike Settled.

Victoria, B. C., June 25.—Dispatches from Ladysmith state that the strike at the coal mines there and at Comox, which has been in progress for some months, has been settled, and there is great rejoicing among the miners.
