Council Meeting

The City council met in adjourned session Thursday evening July 23rd every member being present. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. The chairman then explained that the meeting had been called to consider the passing of an ordinance to amend Section 4 of ordinance 54. The proposed ordinance was then read by the clerk also a petition signed by various citizens asking that the proposed ordinance be passed. The report of the committee on Fire and Police to whom was referred the proposed ordinance was then read and referred the ordinance back to the council without recommendation. After some discussion the ordinance was amended by Mr. Waite the president of the water company. On motion the ordinance was read the first time in full, the second time by title and the third in full and placed on its final passage all members voting for its passage. On motion the council adjourned to meet Wednesday Aug. 5 1903.

Teachers Examination

The next teachers examination will be held at Moscow, Aug. 20, 21, 22nd for life diploma, state certificate, first, second and third grade county and primary certificates. Questions in School Law will be taken from chapter entitled Public School Fund and in State Constitution from art. II. Judicial Department.

On account of this early date the County Institute will convene Aug. 13 instead as announced, and continue to the 20th.

Saturday Aug. 15, will be a meeting of the Latah County Teachers Association.

The instructors, Prof. N. C. Sampson of Pullman and Miss E. Rose St. Clair of Spokane, will make the institute a success.

Pres. J. A. McLean of the University and Miss Zella Perkins will report from the N. E. A.


