

BRITISH CABINET COMPLETED.

New Marquis of Salisbury Accepts Follo.

London, Oct. 13.—The interesting announcement is made that the new marquis of Salisbury (late Viscount Cranborne) will enter the cabinet as lord of the privy seal, the office held by his father until his retirement last year, when Mr. Balfour assumed the post without taking the salary of \$10,000, specially attached to it when the late marquis of Salisbury took the position. The cabinet now consists of 19 members.

The appointment of Lieutenant Colonel William Bromley-Davenport, M. P., as financial secretary to the war office, is confirmed, and the following additional minor appointments have been made:

Secretary to the admiralty, Ernest G. Prettyman; civil lord to the admiralty, Major Arthur H. Lee, M. P., junior lord of the treasury, Major Barcares, M. P.; treasurer of the household, the marquis of Hamilton.

MURDERED ON FREIGHT TRAIN

E. C. PETRIE OF SPOKANE SHOT BY TWO THUGS.

He and G. B. Fulkerson, a Harvester of North Yakima, Riding on Lumber Car When They Were Ordered to Hold Up Their Hands—Fired at Petrie, Ordered Fulkerson to Jump.

Spokane, Oct. 12.—Elmer C. Petrie of 1623 Boone avenue, was shot to death by one of two thugs on a Northern Pacific freight train a short distance west of the high Hangman creek trestle shortly after 8 o'clock Sunday night.

Fulkerson and the victim of the murder were traveling together in a coal car, loaded with lumber, according to Fulkerson's story, when two men came over the top of the train and approached them.

Fulkerson walked to Spokane, and told the police his story. Officers searched the train, which had arrived in the meantime, and had been sidetracked in the freight yards.

Fulkerson says the train was going very rapidly, and that he was almost afraid to get off.

When Petrie's body was searched by Acting Coroner Stocker, the discovery was made that the murderer had not robbed his victim, or if he had, that he had overlooked \$5.20 in money and a gold watch.

UTAH CONVICTS ESCAPE.

Penitentiary Guards Kill One—Wound Two.

As a result of a well organized and partly successful attempt at a wholesale delivery of prisoners at the Utah penitentiary one prisoner was killed, one guard was shot, another was beaten almost into insensibility, three prisoners were wounded and two others under death sentences escaped.

The outbreak occurred about 6 p. m., just as the prisoners were being placed in their cells for the night, by Guards Wilkins and Jacobs. The affair went through with such a vim and precision that it must have been carefully planned beforehand.

As the first convict reached the top, Guard Naylor, who was on the south wall, opened fire. This was the signal for a general alarm, and several guards who were in the office quickly seized their guns and hastened to the scene.

The other five convicts had succeeded in reaching the ground outside the wall, when they were fired upon by other guards.

Two of the prisoners were armed with revolvers. Where they secured the weapons is not known.
