#### Died

At Missoula, Mont., last Thursday night of Brights disease, Mr. P. S. Newell of this place. Mr. Newell had been ailing for some weeks and went to Spokane for treatment, but becoming much worse was taken to the N. P. hospital at Missoula where he died as above stated.

Mr. Newell was one of the picturesque figures of Kendrick, having lived here for eight or ten years attending faithfully to his duties as engineer at the pumping station here and at Troy. He was born in Belfast, Ireland, his father having been professor of mathematics in the university at that place while his brother was a distinguished educator of this country, having been president of the National Teachers' association at one time. The deceased was a pleasant, affable and courteous gentleman, a great friend of the children for whom he always carried some candy or nuts in his pocket. He was buried at Spokane under the auspices of the Masonic fraternity of which he was a member. He leaves a wife but no children, and the whole community sympathize deeply with her in the loss of her companion.
