



Buy the Herd Boar Early.

One of the greatest advantages that the farmer can have in the early purchase of his herd boar lies in the fact that he has first choice from among the animals offered. No breeder has yet succeeded in producing a perfect lot of pigs. The most successful breeders are those who produce the largest number of good pigs, but all breeders produce inferior pigs and those which have only a mediocre quality. The farmer who waits until he is ready to use the boar before buying him is forced to take what is left of the breeding herd after all other sales have been made from it. He may possibly get a good animal, but the chances are against him, and the small cost of feed which the boar consumes during the months before he is actually used is more than offset by this opportunity for first choice and by the fact that the farmer can train the boar himself and fit him to his environment in his new home. There is profit to be had in buying the boars young for these reasons, as well as for the added and important reason that he does not cost so much when bought young as he does when grown to maturity.

Serum For Calf Scours.


In the past considerable loss has been sustained by Wisconsin cattle breeders from a fatal disease of calves known as white scours or calf dysentery. The veterinary science department of the college of agriculture of the University of Wisconsin calls attention to a serum which has been found especially reliable as a preventive treatment for this disease. White scours occur in the newborn calf and is manifested by a very profuse, malodorous white diarrhea, which usually results in death within a few hours. On account of its infectious nature affected calves and their dams must be isolated to prevent the disease from spreading to other animals. Careful disinfection of the navel and contaminated surroundings must not be neglected.

Sheep and Fertility.


The sheep is just as efficient a manure spreader as he is a manure maker. On hillsides where coarser animal waste would hardly stick long enough to do the ground any good sheep droppings take the place of a specially prepared fertilizer.

Look to the Lame Ewe.

Catch the lame ewe and see if she isn't in the first stages of foot rot. Looks like it from here, though it may be that her hoof only needs trimming.

LIVE STOCK TALK.

Horses must be upheaded, have spirit and finish and be fast walkers.

Be sure the box for salt in the sheep quarters is kept filled. Drop everything to help a horse or a cow that is in trouble, no matter whether it is your own or your neighbor's.

Farming on a business basis eliminates small mules just as it displaces small horses.

Beef cattle may be raised on many farms, and there are good reasons for raising them. Not the least of these is that they provide a means of building up the farm in fertility.

There are profits in raising good horses and mules as one of the features of farming. Get a few good mares and let them bring you a good income raising horses and mules.

Those who have silos full of silage find winter feeding easy and satisfactory to the live stock.

Care of Swine.

Two things which should be avoided with swine in cold weather are, first, do not let them sleep in or upon heating manure, because they become warm and then rush into the cold air, frequently contracting colds, coughs or severe pulmonary diseases that are sometimes fatal; second, bed them well in dry quarters where there is no draft of air blowing across them.

Beware of the Dog!

In Jersey they have an interesting device for keeping off tramps and burglars. A watchdog, too ferocious and too valuable to be allowed to run loose, is tied to a rope about four feet long, and this rope is tied to a ring that runs loosely over a long wire about four feet from the ground.
