### Commissioners Proceedings.

(Continued.)  
Whereupon the Board of Commissioners adjourned and the Board of Commissioners convened as per adjournment of October 12th.

In the matter of the petition of Ben F. Gillett, et al, for the organization of an irrigation district.  
In this matter, the State Engineer not having filed his report, the further consideration of the petition is postponed until 2 o'clock p. m. January 10th, 1905.

It appearing that on the 27th day of January, 1904, the Board made an order defining and establishing the boundaries of Parker School District, No. 28, and that the said boundaries were incorrectly and erroneously described, the boundaries of said School District No. 28 are hereby corrected and defined so as to conform with the amended decree of the District Court in this matter, as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point one-half mile east of the sw corner of section 17, twp 9 n, r 40 e, b m., thence north 2 miles, thence west 1 mile, thence north one-half mile, thence west one and three-fourths miles, thence north one-half mile to the northwest corner of ne 1/4 ne 1/4 of section 2, twp 9 n, r 39 e, b m., thence west 10 1/2 miles, thence north 6 miles, thence west about 9 miles, to the easterly boundary of the Oregon Short Line Railway company's right of way, thence in a northerly direction along said easterly boundary line 1/2 miles, thence east about 25 miles to the ne corner of sect 22, twp 9 n, r 40 e, b m., thence south to the north bank of the North Fork of Snake river, thence in a southeasterly direction along the north bank of said river to the place of beginning.

In the matter of the petition of O. Henrie and other residents of Fremont county:
