A Cornfield Protected by Rattlesnakes.
An octogenarian, of Dresden, had been troubled, during corn-planting time, by the crows stealing the corn planted. Sometimes a crow would raise a few feet from the ground, with the snake tightly bound about its neck, when it would soon tumble to earth, dead.
