**PATENT AND PROPRIETARY  
 MEDICINE FRAUDS**

This department has repeatedly called  
 your attention to the fact that patent  
 and proprietary medicines are  
 among the worst regulated products  
 on sale in this country. Many of the  
 so-called patent medicines are entirely  
 worthless—they are even dangerous to  
 users of the same—and it is noteworthy  
 that the American Public Health associa-  
 tion, at its annual meeting at Roch-  
 ester, New York, passed the following  
 resolution, which should be of interest  
 to the people of this State:

"WHEREAS, The widespread use of  
 and traffic in patent medicines and  
 secret nostrums constitute a grave  
 menace to the public health, and

WHEREAS, Such patent medicines  
 and nostrums, because of the deceptive  
 advertising regularly employed in pro-  
 moting their sales, consistently oppose  
 the influences seeking to educate the  
 public to a better understanding of the  
 nature, causes and proper treatment of  
 diseases, and

WHEREAS, The bulwark of this  
 traffic is mystery,  
 "BE IT RESOLVED, That this associa-  
 tion heartily endorse the ordinance of  
 the New York City department of  
 health, requiring the manufacturers of  
 proprietary remedies, sold without a  
 physician's prescription, to file with the  
 department a statement of its active  
 constituents and therapeutic claims, and

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,  
 That this association recommend to  
 other municipalities the adoption of this  
 or similar measures for the proper safe-  
 guarding of the public health."  
 Under the Shirley amendment of the  
 pure food and drugs act, which gives  
 the government the right to pass on  
 the claims of curative qualities ad-  
 vanced by the manufacturers of the  
 medicine, the federal department of  
 agriculture has fined and confiscated  
 the goods of many concerns who market  
 their products through the drug  
 store.

Diseases, which the manufacturers  
 claimed their preparations would cure  
 ranged from tuberculosis, smallpox and  
 diphtheria to coughs, colds and scalp  
 diseases.

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
