It is Clipperton island, a little isle in the Pacific ocean, ten degrees north and 109 degrees longitude west. It is one of a large group of islands which is visited periodically by a French warship.

Some time ago, when the warship visited the island, the French sailors found soldiers there in Mexican uniform, and the Mexican flag floating serenely over the island.

The island is directly east of the mouth of the Panama canal, which gives it a certain amount of importance.

The matter has been placed in the hands of the French foreign office, and "communications are pending." The warship discovered that the French government had mislaid the island two years ago.

SURVEYORS TO WORK ON NEW GOLDFIELD ROAD.

General Manager Ryan of the Tonopah & Tidewater railroad arrived in the city yesterday afternoon says the White Pine News of last Saturday, and will be here for a couple of days. Mr. Ryan was very tired after a hard trip across country from Death Valley, but before going to his room last night at the Steptoe in East Ely, stopped long enough to talk a few minutes with a reporter, whom he told that a surveying corps would be put in the field almost immediately to work out the details of the findings which Chief Engineer Rasor and Locating Engineer Vandewerk have made during their reconnaissance of the country during the last month.

Mr. Ryan added that the investigation to date had developed more difficulties to overcome in the matter of gaining entry to the camp than had been expected and that longer time than at first estimated would probably as a result intervene between the beginning of work by the surveyors and the beginning of grading. Much is ahead in getting over the several routes which are to be thoroughly examined before choice is made.
