Notice is hereby given, that Alexander McKay, whose post office address is Virginia City, Madison county, Montana, has this day filed his application for a patent for 1599 linear feet of the Geel lode, 1599 linear feet of the Matchless lode and 533 linear feet of the North Star lode, with surface ground 600 feet in width on the south end of the said lodes—the same being adjoining claims, and situated in Hamburg, an unorganized, mining district, Madison county, Montana, and designated in the official field notes and plat on file in this office, as surveys Nos. 4467, 4468 and 4469, embracing a portion of township 4, south of range 3 west of the principal meridian; said surveys Nos. 4467, 4468 and 4469 being described as follows, to-wit:

The Geel lode, Survey No. 4467.
