### SCHOOL TERM IS NEARING THE END

Final Exams in Progress at Public School, Which Will Be First to Close.

In a few weeks more all the schools in the city will close for the summer months. The first one to close will be the public school, which will end this session on Friday, May 28th.

This will be the only school in the city to have commencement exercises. The first of these exercises will be held in the public school building on Thursday afternoon, May 27, at 3 o'clock. The entertainment to be given by the lower grades will consist of recitations, music, drills and dialogues. On Friday night an entertainment will be given by those of the higher grades and will be practically the same as that of Thursday afternoon, with the exception of the graduating exercises. This year there is only one graduate, Simon Garcia. Final examinations are in progress at this school now.

St. Joseph's College will hold final examinations June 17th and will close June 21st, to reopen the 1st Sept.

The parochial school of Our Lady of Guadalupe will begin to hold final examinations the first week in June, closing directly the examinations are over.

The school of the Immaculate Conception, for small boys, will also hold its final examinations during the first week in June closing immediately after.

The Academy of the Incarnate Word will hold final examinations the last two weeks in June and will close June 29.

On account of the warm weather and the strain necessarily imposed upon the pupils in preparing for their final examinations, commencement exercises will not be held at the academy, but the exercises will be given next fall at the opening of the fall term.
